1 Select a boat to suit your party size

All our boats are classified according to how many people they comfortably sleep.

If a boat is listed as 6+2 it means it sleeps six people comfortably in cabins - with the option to sleep two further people on a convertible bed in the saloon area.

It is often a good idea to have an extra cabin to store belongings - as well as any goods you might buy on your travels.
